To whom it may concern,

I wish to submit this letter to Council as a formal complaint against Ross Auto Classic held on 12/3/2017 in Ross from 8am to 4pm for the following reasons:

- 1. That the organisers failed to understand the implications of this event for the whole town and only concentrated their efforts in the time trial area. Notifications were only sent to households inside the designated area prior to race day, none sent to those outside the area and within the town.
- 2. That the organisers failed to supervise and co-ordinate the warm up prior to the event in our back streets. This involved extremely noisy cars, speeding in any direction on any public street and into blind corners. This was chaotic, dangerous, frightening and unnecessary. The Police were rung at this point, before the start of the event.
- 3. That <u>all</u> race cars were converging in The Boulevards which <u>was not</u> closed off to the public. After a time trial competitors were directed into the Boulevards coming from Bond Street and race cars were also coming from Waterloo Street into the Boulevards. This meant that for 8 hours powerful race cars were travelling with local traffic, spectator traffic, deer hunters coming off Stony Gulley Road onto the Boulevards and even two 8 year old girls on bikes.
- 4. That some drivers after a time trial chose to continue driving at speed, with attitude and disrespect for residents on public roads designated 50 kph and not closed off for the event.
- 5. That this event is in NO way conducive to a quiet historic town.
- 6. That closing our streets for 8 hours and with 5 minutes of opening on the hour was restricting, unreasonable and inconvenient. Liberties were taken from residents wishing to leave or return to their homes during this time. Liberties were also taken from drivers wishing to use the Tooms Lake Road.
- 7. That the continuous noise made by the hotted up cars for 8 hours was stressful and worrying particularly concerning for our elderly and sick residents.
- 8. That at 7:00am on Sunday morning prior to the event starting at 8 am, a race car was driving around the back streets at speed and with noise.

When the Targa event came to Ross they were properly organised and safety issues were paramount. We had no objections to Targa and even worked for them.

This event is nothing like Targa. Please do not confuse the two.

Could race organisers please consider Symmons Plains as an alternative for this event in future?
