Proclaimed Town of Lymington gazetted or proclaimed on 3/7/1866. Originally Municipality of Evandale. Now Nile, previously known as Lymington on Nile

The town was proclaimed under the Police Act 1865. The area of the town presently known as Nile, allegedly the name was changed in 1910. As of 17/6/2011, there has been no proclamation found confirming the change from Lymington to Nile (Named after the river and possibly Nile Farm, a farmhouse built about 1840). Termed 'Lymington - Nile', 'Lymington on Nile', 'Lymington River Nile' and even 'Lymington North' to avoid confusion. Name was apparently changed to avoid confusion but no evidence found to support renaming.


