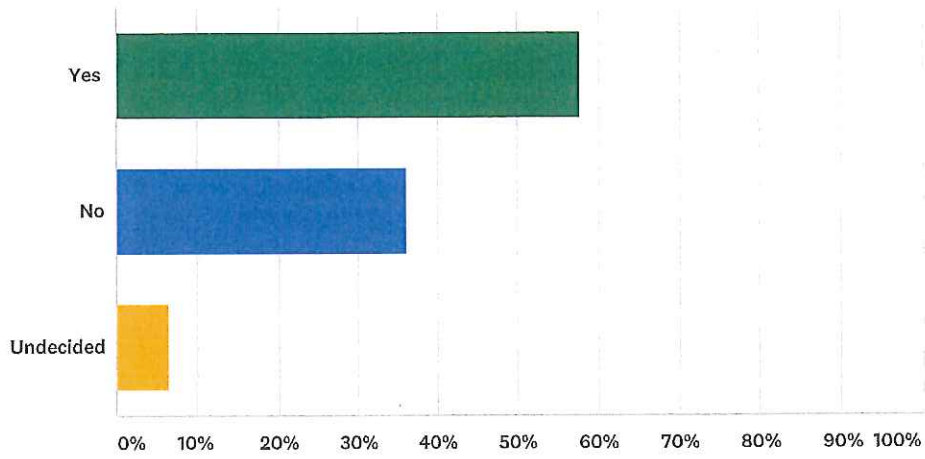


Q1 Do you like the current size of the existing flower pots in Perth?

Answered: 170 Skipped: 0

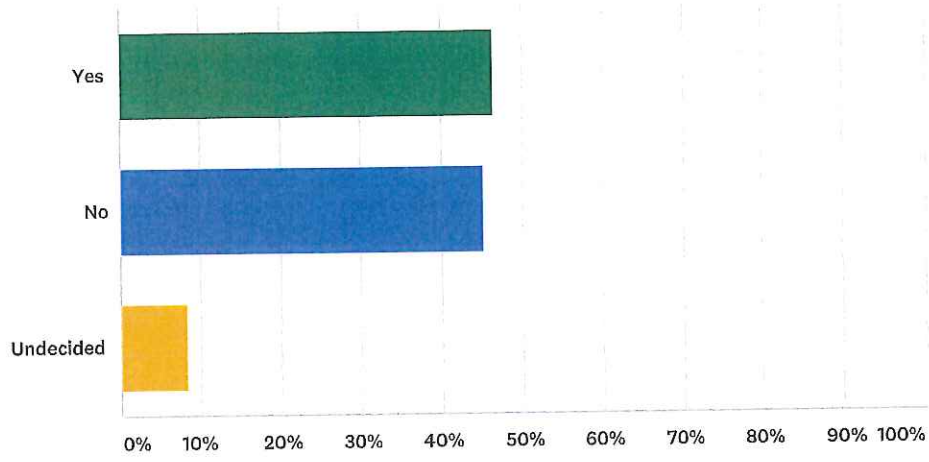

Answered: 168 Skipped: 2

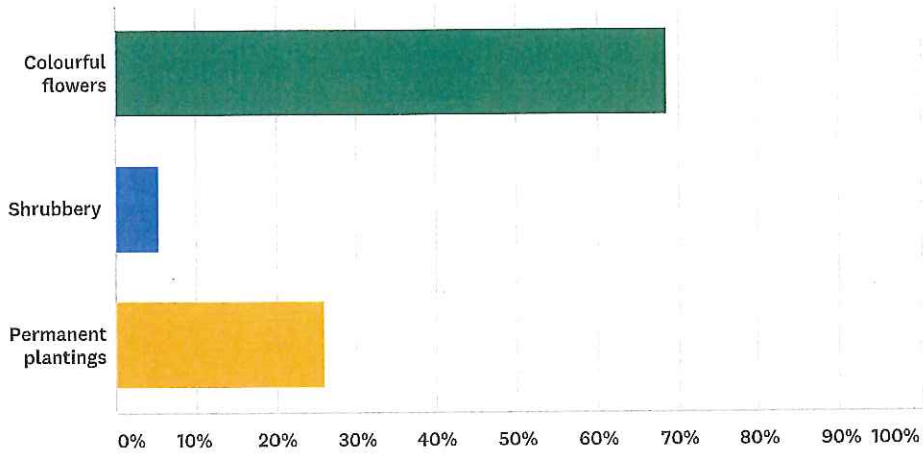

Answered: 166 Skipped: 4

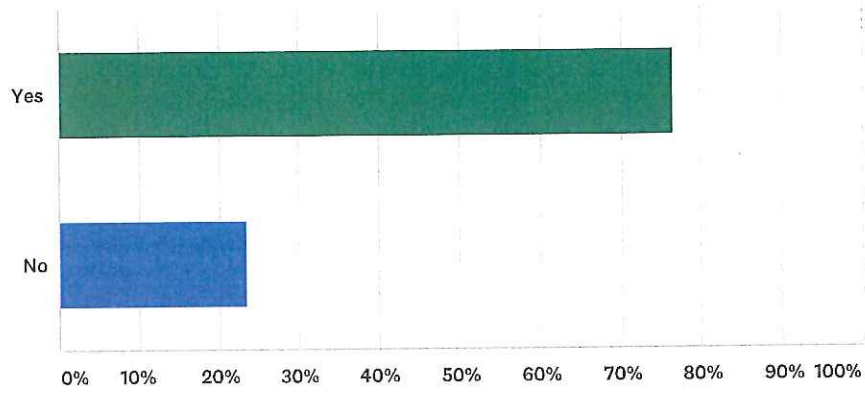
