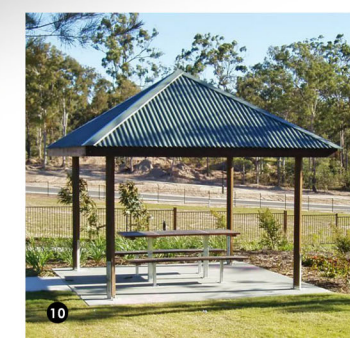
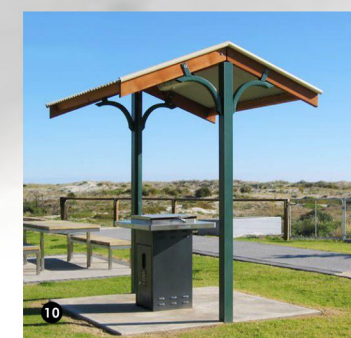
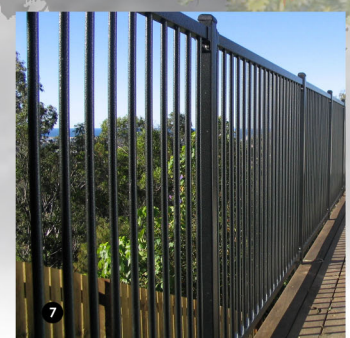
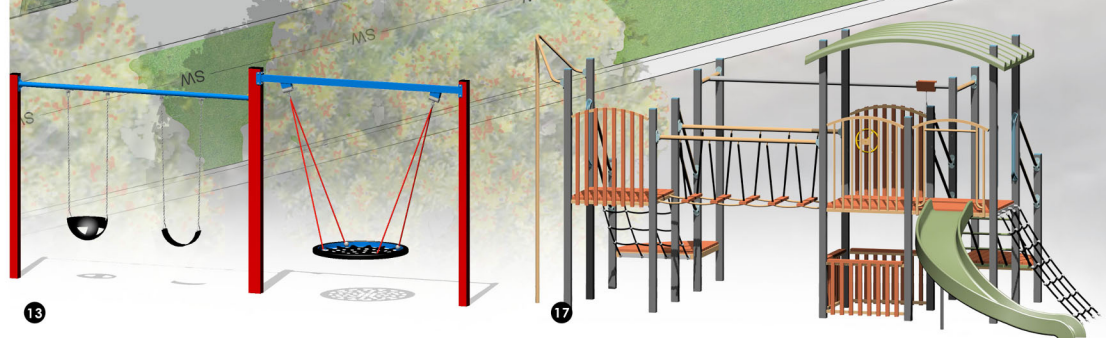


**NUMBER LEGEND**

- 1 Self-closing gates provides security within the park and keeps out straying dogs.
- 2 1800mm (h) timber paling fence along the full length of the southern boundary.
- 3 Screen planting consisting of durable native plants such as tussocks, shrubs and small trees.
- 4 1500mm (w) concrete footpath.
- 5 Open lawn area with parkland grass species sow into existing pasture grass.
- 6 Seating with backrest and arm rests over a concrete base slab.
- 7 Low growing planting strip along the perimeter of the park with a 150mm (w) concrete edging, and a 1200 mm (h) black pool fence to enclose the park.
- 8 New streetscape works to Laycock Street including grass verge, street trees, 1500mm (w) concrete path and new kerb and channelling.
- 9 Planting buffer between the intersection and the picnic facilities, consisting of hardy groundcovers and clear trunked native trees.
- 10 Picnic shelter (4 x 4m), over an accessible picnic table, and a separate shelter (4 x 2m), over an accessible electric BBQ.
- 11 Coloured concrete pavement providing a durable all weather surface fronting the playspace and the picnic area.
- 12 Earth brown coloured wet pour rubber soft fall provides all-weather access to the play equipment.
- 13 Three bay swing consisting of a basket for all abilities, toddler swing and an adult swing.
- 14 150mm (w) concrete edging to provide a durable barrier between the adjoining surfaces.
- 15 Informal boulders under 600mm (h) for informal play opportunities.
- 16 Three feature Maple trees for seasonal colour and shade during summer.
- 17 Multi-play structure for a variety of age groups and challenges.
- 18 Log and tree stump steppers below 600mm (h) for informal and quiet play opportunities.
- 19 Low planting buffer around the playspace to enclose the space with greenery and shade.
- 20 Existing street trees (Elms) to be retained.
- 21 New 1800mm (w) concrete footpath along Wellington Street.
